

CMT REVEALS THE NEW CAST OF “REDNECK ISLAND,” THE ULTIMATE REDNECK-STYLE COMPETITION SERIES DEBUTING NOVEMBER 10

Host Steve Austin set to Tweet Live throughout the November 10 Premiere at 9 p.m. ET

NASHVILLE – October 31, 2012 – Returning for his second season as host of REDNECK ISLAND, wrestling hall of famer Steve Austin will take 14 new red, white and blue-collared Americans out of their element, and far away from cold beer, for the next round of CMT’s ultimate redneck-style competition series, which debuts Saturday, November 10 at 9:00-10:00 p.m. ET/PT. In the first episode, the competition turns serious quickly as contestants discover their first challenge is a game of human cornhole. Throughout the 10-episode season, the group must overcome tough mental and physical challenges to prove they are the reddest of them all and win \$100,000.

- Wade Jones (Our Town, Ala.) – Everyone’s favorite country store manager, this 40-year-old redneck loves singing his heart out at karaoke and is proud of his redneck car collection.
- Kyle Medina (White House, Tenn.) – This height-loving high school wrestling coach spends his spare time mudding, hunting and getting crazy after a few beers.
